Chardon Twp WWTP & Sewer Project Update

- Based on weather conditions next week, construction may be postponed.
- TRAX Construction installed the Henning Drive sewer main line from Thwing Road to just north of Howard Drive; will continue up Henning Dr week of 2/8/21, weather permitting.
- Lateral lines have been installed along Henning Dr., south of Howard Dr.
- TRAX has installed the sewer line on Howard Drive and started down Olmar Dr.
- TRAX has completed all borings under Thwing Road. Work will begin on the north side of Thwing Road, vicinity of Olmar Drive and west on 2/2/21. Tree removal is complete.
- The electrical and plumbing rough-in work continues at the WWTP operations building. The concrete floors will be begin once the weather warms up.
- To date the following has been completed:
 - 8” sewer mainline - 6,000 lf
 - 6” laterals/bores installed up to Fowlers Mill on Thwing – 980 lf of steel casing bores
 - 15 laterals on Henning
 - 23 ft deep lift station installed
 - 4” forcemain – 850 lf to lift station
- An updated construction schedule has been posted to the website. When the County accepts the project, residents will be able to tie-in. At this point, consider August 2021 through January 2022 as the time frame for tying in. *Please note that this is the current schedule which may change.*
