Geauga County Planning Commission is continuing a public engagement process to gather community input for an update to their General Plan to guide future policy decisions and development.

The public engagement process included a Community Survey conducted earlier this year which identified four planning themes: (1) Preserving Rural Character, (2) Economic Development, (3) Housing, and (4) Connections.

The Planning Commission encourages residents to participate in one of four Public Forums being held across the County to engage with the planning team in a series of outreach activities to gain a deeper understanding of public preferences on each planning theme identified in the Community Survey.

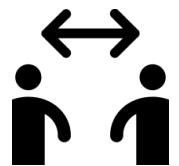
